Geeplus couldn't find a suitable cable tidy so they designed their own

Fed up with constantly having to untangle cables on desktop instruments, Geeplus set about finding a solution in vain. As a result, they designed their own and their new cable tidy CT1-22 clears up cable clutter for small instruments or USB devices and is available to all who have the

a similar problem.

Passing cables through the individual tidies avoids the twisting and knotting of leads, which arises when instruments are repeatedly picked up and put down.

The novel cable 'bobble' allows the user to control the length of cable through the device without excessive pulling, and likewise, the cable can be dropped through the desktop to keep cables out of the way when not in use. Currently suitable for use used with devices or instruments with



connectors small enough to pass through the 22mm hole although Geeplus have indicated that larger sizes will soon be available.

Easily installed in a 38mm (1-1/2") hole in worktops 12-40mm thick. The large nut can be done up securely by hand without any need for tools.
